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# METOДИЧЕСКАЯ РАЗРАБОТКА УРОКА ПО TEME «MODERN ENGLISH AND AMERICAN HOUSES»

Аннотация: в статье описывается один из возможных уроков английского языка в школе. Авторы ставят четкие цели и задачи данного занятия. Каждый из учебных этапов детально расписан, огромный практический материал способствует хорошему усвоению материала.

**Ключевые слова**: урок английского языка, текст, грамматика, диалогическое единство.

#### Цели:

- 1) познавательный аспект знакомство с особенностями структуры английских и американских домов;
- 2) развивающий аспект совершенствование способностей к сравнению и сопоставлению, к выявлению причинно-следственных связей в тексте, к формулированию выводов из прочитанного;
- 3) *воспитательный аспект* совершенствование потребности, способности к осознанию образа жизни людей другой культуры и своей родной культуры;

- 4) *учебный аспект* совершенствование навыков чтения с поиском информации;
- 5) *сопутствующая задача* совершенствование умения говорить на основе прочитанного (развитие умения осуществлять репродуктивные и продуктивные речевые действия).

Речевой материал:

- рецептивный;
- лексический;
- грамматический.

Ход урока:

- 1.1 Задание до прочтения текста.

Приложение 3

Речь какого-либо человека, передаваемая как его подлинные слова, называется прямой.

Вопросы в косвенной речи.

В косвенной речи вопросы имеют прямой порядок слов, а вопросительный знак в конце предложения заменяется на точку.

Общие вопросы вводятся союзами if и whether:

I asked, «Have you seen my pen?» – Я спросил: «Ты видел мою ручку?»

I asked him whether/if he had seen my pen. – Я спросил, видел ли он мою ручку.

Специальные вопросы вводятся вопросительными словами:

He wondered: «Who on earth will buy this junk?» – Он удивился: «Ну кто станет покупать эту рухлядь?»

He wondered who on earth will buy this junk. – Он удивился, кто станет покупать эту рухлядь.

Краткий ответ на вопрос косвенной речи вводится союзом that без слов yes/no:

She answered, «Yes, I do.» – Она ответила: «Да».

She answered that she did. - Она ответила утвердительно.
